

South Texas Veterinary Ophthalmology (STVO) and The Greller Gallery are joining forces with the San Antonio Humane Society (SAHS) to support the tremendous animal rescue and relief efforts being organized throughout the Texas coastal areas and Houston.

Since Hurricane Harvey began its devastation, the SAHS continues to shelter and assist pets displaced and at risk due to the destructive weather. As a result, the SAHS has rescued, temporarily sheltered, and/or transferred 325+ dogs and cats from devastated areas and supplied or plan to help supply shelters in Corpus Christi, Portland, Aransas Pass, and Houston.

On Monday, September 18th, STVO and The Greller Gallery will begin accepting donations to support the SAHS and offset some of its growing expenses as the non-profit continues to shelter and care for pet evacuees and strays affected by Hurricane Harvey.
